# Every Child Ready to Read Skill

## Sing

Songs introduce new words to your littles. Try using familiar songs to do this like *Bingo*, but replace *Bingo* with other words. Songs can help littles learn basic math as well as sizes, with songs such as “One, Two, Buckle My Shoe” and “Big, Bigger, Biggest.” Help your littles learn the hand motions to songs and then you can let them make up their own. Encourage them to act out the songs.
